Grain Inspection Fees and Charges

Effective Date

December 1, 2013. Federal Grain Inspection Service (FGIS) must approve all fees for official services and official agencies will assess only those fees appearing on their current approved fee schedules. FGIS user fees are included in the unit fees of this fee schedule.

Regular Hours

Lincoln, NE office - Monday through Friday from 7:00 am to 4:00 pm. Farwell, TX office - Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. All hourly rates assessed in half-hour increments. Lincoln Inspection Service (LIS) reserves the right to determine the number of inspection personnel to properly service the customer.

Regular Hourly Rate

\$20.00 per hour per person.

Overtime Hourly Rate

One and one-half times regular hourly rate. Applies to Saturday and other than regular hours. Minimum of 4 hours per person is assessed for Saturday, Sunday, Holidays and hours outside regular hours if not directly preceding or following working hours.

Sunday and Holiday Hourly Rate

Double the regular hourly rate. Holidays include: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and after 11:00 am on Christmas Eve and Friday after Thanksgiving. If a Holiday falls on a Saturday, LIS will observe it on Friday. If a Holiday falls on a Sunday, LIS will observe it on Monday.

Mileage

The IRS standard mileage rate will be assessed per mile actual miles traveled. Any change to the mileage rate is effective when the IRS changes their standard mileage rate. Mileage and travel time will be prorated when it is possible.

Official Inspection Services

Sampling, mileage, and delivery charges are in addition to unit fees listed. Standby and travel hours will be assessed at applicable hourly rates. All requests for service will be honored as soon as possible on a first call-first service basis. All requests for service should be ordered by 2:00 pm the preceding day or the preceding Friday for the weekend.



Official Commercial Inspections

Official Commercial Inspections are offered and will be negotiated on a case-by-case basis from our officially approved fee schedule.

Standby Time

If the sampler/inspector is at the work site and available to work and the customer causes delays, they will be charged the applicable hourly rate.

Cancellation Charges

If a start time is established during non-regular hours and the elevator cancels prior to the start time, a 4-hour per person cancellation charge will be assessed.

On-Call Time

On-call time is when an applicant wants personnel available after regular hours, but not on site. Personnel are off site waiting to report for duty. The elevator will establish a starting time. Elevator personnel will contact agency personnel before the starting time to report on the loading status. If the elevator is not ready, an on-call charge of 2 hours per personnel per day will be assessed at the applicable hourly rate if the request for service is not cancelled.

PER DIEM

\$30 per day per individual plus actual lodging expenses when staying overnight is required or requested.

Submitted Samples Pickup

Customers requesting submitted samples picked up at their location will be allowed 2 pickups per week at no cost if within a 30 mile radius of the Farwell, Texas inspection office. Any additional trips per week at the customer request will be charged the IRS standard mileage rate. This fuel surcharge is being added because of high fuel prices; however, the customer can drop off or use another shipment method to deliver samples to our office.

Official Sample-Lot Inspection (White Certificate) Plus Sampling Fee

FGIS user fees are included in all unit fees at the rate of 1.1 cents per metric ton.
